On February 2nd, Mount Olivet Careview Home had the privilege of hosting U.S. Senator Amy Klobuchar to celebrate key milestones of the Inflation Reduction Act. Last month, the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) unveiled the list of 15 drugs that Medicare will now be able to negotiate prices with pharmaceutical companies. In her speech, Senator Klobuchar highlighted that the 10 drugs announced in August 2024 alone are expected to save seniors around \$1.5 billion by 2026.
